This program has enabled youth to increase their skills, explore career options and gain exposure to the field of healthcare.

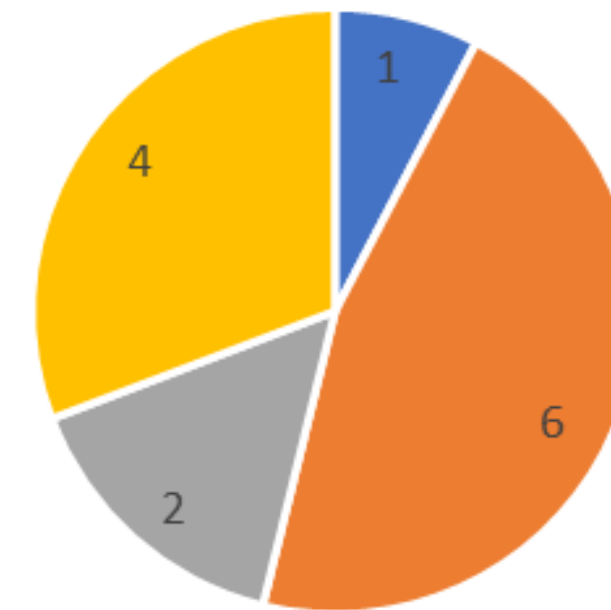

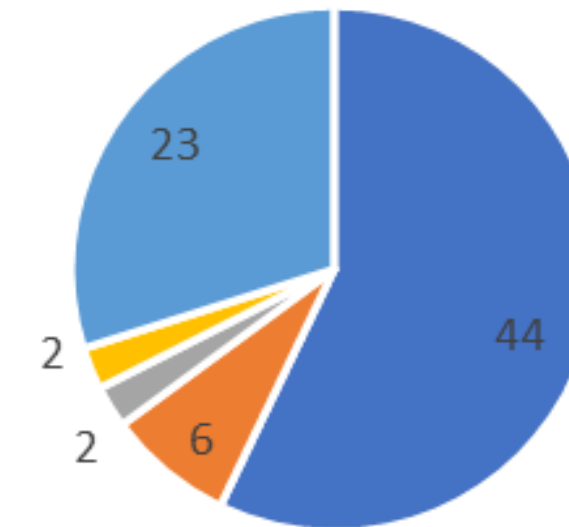

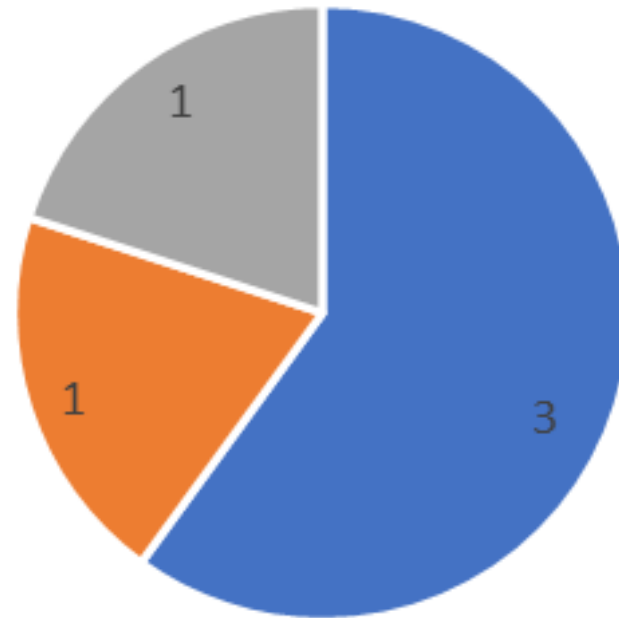
